In 2011 a group of women who were looking to help out a young mother

who'd just been diagnosed with terminal cancer, started Sashay for Sacha. Sacha (Curran) McGrath lived in Mackinaw most of her life, she was very proud of her hometown community and was very touched by the loving support shown to her and her family as she was dealt a terminal diagnosis. This run/walk keeps Sacha's memory alive but also continues to raise money to give back to the community that gave so much to her. \$63,000 has been raised, all of which has gone back to the community. Money raised this year will go towards playground improvements at West wood Park in Mackinaw. **The race is being held on October 6th at 10 AM at Veterans Park in Mackinaw. There will be a timed 5K run along with a 1.5 mile walk, also, live music, face painting and a bounce house/slide for kids. Food will be available for purchase at the Mackinaw IGA's cook-out.**

Welcome

We welcome all families and individuals to St. Joseph's Hopedale and St. Mary's Delavan and encourage registration in the parish as soon as possible. Registration forms are available in back of church or at the parish office in Delavan.

Active parish membership is a condition for the reception of the sacraments. It is required before the parish can issue a sponsorship certificate for those asked to be sacramental sponsors. Active parish membership is required for families whose children attend CCD.

An active parishioner is one who has completed a registration form and participates regularly at Holy Mass. Offertory envelopes are the primary means of determining regular participation. Attendance at Holy mass is the most meaningful way we model and live our Catholic faith.
