CCD Grades K-6 will be using a program called Family Formation. The catechesis model of this program is based on the Church teaching that parents are the first and the foremost educators of their children. It combines one monthly classroom lesson, the first week of each month, followed by weekly home lessons. During the monthly lesson, parents will have adult formation & home lesson training while the students meet for the classroom lesson. The cost is \$20 per family.

A kickoff event is scheduled for Wednesday, 9/16, 6:30 pm—7:30 pm, at St. Joseph.

The program will be explained to the parents while the children are entertained with games outside. After Fr. Tim's talk about Angels, the first lesson of the program, there will be time for Q&A.
