All the Holy Souls need our help. As you know, November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory and the Church gives us the beautiful gift of a plenary indulgence for our deceased loved ones. Normally, this is granted between the 1st and the 8th. This year, due to COVID-19, the Church, in her grace, has extended those 8 days to any day in November and has adjusted the requirements. To receive the indulgence:

1 Visit your loved one in the graveyard, or mentally visit, and say some devotional prayers.

2. Then do the normal conditions for the indulgence:

A. Receive Communion (or a spiritual act of communion if you can't get there)

B. Get to Confession within 20 days (or an Act of Contrition if Confession is not available)

C. Pray for the intentions of our Holy Father, usually with an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.

And then work on that "no attachment to sin".
