

Handbook Updates for 2019-2020

Incidents which occur on the private bus such as fighting, inappropriate language and cell phone activity etc., and carry over to SMS campus may result in punishment by the school such as, suspension or expulsion.

Making false statements about a teacher or other staff member orally, written or via social media may result in disciplinary action.

Ipods, cell phones, cameras, eReaders, Smart Watches and other similar items are not to be brought to school unless authorized by the principal.

1st – offense – device held for 10 school days

2nd offense – device held for 20 school days

3rd offense – device held for remainder of the school year.

(If parent/student refuses to allow school to hold device, student may be suspended instead for up to 3 days)

Even though cell phones are not allowed, if a device is brought to school, the following is applicable: Inappropriate behavior with the use of a cell phone such as but not limited to: video, pictures, texting, sexting etc. shall result in confiscation of the phone for a period of time determined by the phone policy, and may result in suspension or possibly expulsion.

Leggings/Jeggins cannot be worn as pants, even on free dress day.

Blankets are not allowed at school

Students must have A-B Honor Roll at the end of the last nine weeks of the previous year to be invited to join Jr. Beta in the 6-8 grades.

Former students who are now in other schools are not allowed to visit classrooms on their “days off”.

Teachers are in charge of all field trips and will make all the decisions regarding any aspect of the trip before, during and after with the Principal’s approval. All rules in the handbook apply during the field trip.

If students are not picked up in a timely manner in the afternoons, they will be placed in after school care and the parent will be billed through FACTS.
