

2020-2021 St. Mary's Assumption School Handbook Updates

- Pandemic guidelines are a separate document on our website and they supersede the handbook and may change as directed.
- Pre K students must be potty trained. After 3 “accidents” child may be asked to withdraw from SMS.
- If a student is withdrawn for home-schooling, documentation must be provided to SMS showing approval within 10 days. Child will be reported to Child Welfare and Attendance. No refund of any tuition paid. If the child re-enters, records must be presented and evaluated to determine grade placement.
- Student of the Year candidates must have a minimum 3.5 cumulative G.P.A. to compete.
- Athletic fees will be determined prior to sign up for the sport.
- Parents who attend class parties must be Virtus Trained and numbers will be limited and determined by the teacher.
- Students who eat breakfast must be **IN** the cafeteria no later than 7:35
- Car riders must enter the loop gate, not front office, by 7:40. Any student entering the front office will be marked tardy.
- The return date on Dr's excuses will be checked thoroughly. No student should return to school prior to the return date. Parents will be called to pick up the child.
- Student water bottles should be labeled and only contain water. Bottle filling station are available to refill their bottles
- All outerwear (jackets, hoodies etc) must have child's name written on the label or somewhere for identification.
- Tuition is based on a yearly rate divided into 11 payments. Attendance does not affect rate or payment amount. Any school closure will not affect tuition rate.
- Parents **MUST** create and use their ParentsWeb(RenWeb) account for their child's lessons, assignments, homework, grades, etc. Teachers will not provide lessons in any other format. Should another school closure occur, teachers, parents and students will be better prepared to receive assignments.
