We are excited that you are interested in the St. Patrick Catholic Higher Education Scholarship. This scholarship is available to any member of St. Patrick Parish who has graduated from high school and who wishes to obtain a higher education. Following is more information about this scholarship.

Purpose: To encourage and promote a sense of a caring church family community for parishioners by morally and financially supporting their pursuit of an advanced education.

Funding: Donations from individuals, church organizations, bequests, etc. The number and amount awarded each year will be determined by need and the amount of money available for this fund. The amount currently is \$500 for each recipient.

Awarding: To be determined by a point system based on financial need, academic achievement, church involvement, school and community activities, and/or outside employment.

We recognize that each applicant is an individual with varying needs. The application has been designed to gather information through specific questions as well as written responses. If necessary, a personal interview may be requested of applicants.

Please note that there are two types of applications enclosed in this packet.

- **The Dependent Application** is to be completed by students who are claimed on their parent's tax return.
- **The Independent Application** should be completed by those *not* claimed as a dependent.

Wouldn't it be wonderful if we could award each applicant the finances needed to complete their education? Perhaps someday, but whether you are awarded this scholarship or not, we want to wish you God's blessings as you work to reach your goals.

**APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR
ST. PATRICK CATHOLIC HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP**

1. Determine if you need to complete the **DEPENDENT** or **INDEPENDENT** application form:
 - a. Dependent application is for applicants claimed on their parent's tax return
 - b. Independent application is for those not claimed on their parent's tax return.
2. Complete all information that applies to you. All information will be held in the strictest confidence. It is your responsibility to see that **all** parts for the application, *including references*, are in the hands of the Committee by May 10, 2021. Forward to:

3. **Write a paragraph** (*minimum*) telling what career you would like to follow and your reasons for choosing this career. State which college or vocational school you have chosen to attend and the reason for your selection. *Attach the paragraph to this application.*
4. **Attach a transcript of your grades** throughout high school or the last semester of college that you have completed.
5. **Complete the Church Involvement Sheet** and return with application.
6. Request **two references** using the Recommendation Form attached to this application.
7. Sign the attached **Authorization to Release Information** and return with the application.

It is your responsibility to see that all parts of the application are in the hands of the Committee by May 10, 2021. This includes references or other materials you have requested from someone else.

By May 10, the Committee should have the following in their hands:

The Committee will meet as soon as possible after May 10 and all candidates will be notified in writing of the Committee's decision.
