**Summertime Family Activity:  
Keep a Nature Journal**



Children love making observations of the outdoors at any time of the year, but especially in summer. Start a journal for your child and decorate it with bright, cutout images from a magazine to personalize it. Then, invite your child to explore the outdoors with you. Look for interesting plants, insects, flowers, rocks and animal life. Bring a magnifying glass and some colored pencils. Show your child how to make observations and draw pictures of what you see, using labels and notes. You will find that this activity not only keeps up academic skills over the summer but also sparks wonderful questions and engaging conversations with your child.
