**We reserve the right to have the final decision on student eligibility to return to PSR classes.**

Teachers and students will be screened for potential COVID-19 symptoms or exposure:

**Send Home if ANY:** Fever ( $\geq 100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$ ), headache, shortness of breath, cough, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain. Some individuals (especially adults) may present with congestion/runny nose, new loss of smell or taste, nausea, fatigue, muscle or body aches. **OR Exposure\* to COVID-19 positive person**

**\*Exposure is defined as close contact (within 6 feet) for longer than 15 minutes with no mask.**

If you have **ANY** of the symptoms: **Call your Physician** (see chart for recommendations)

## **Siblings/Household members:**

- If a student is sent home sick with suspected COVID-19 symptoms, the rest of the household must be quarantined until an alternative diagnosis is made or a negative result received with a physician note to return to class.
- If the sick student becomes a confirmed case or a probable case, the local health department conducting contact tracing will place household contacts in quarantine for 14 calendar days. Return to school for siblings would be decided based on current guidelines at that time.
- If someone in the household has been tested for COVID and results are pending; all students in that household would be expected to self quarantine until a final result is available.
