GUIDELINES FOR RESUMING MASS

What to Know

Parishioners in the Archdiocese of Washington are under no obligation to attend Mass until further notice.

If you are considered "vulnerable," feel sick in any way, or have been exposed to someone with coronavirus in the past 14 days, do not enter the church.

Those considered vulnerable include anyone who:

- Is over 65 (strongly advised to follow **Safer at Home** directive)
- Has a preexisting heart or lung condition
- Has diabetes
- Is immunocompromised in any way

Church restrooms are open but all are encouraged to prepare before arriving to limit use.

All hymnals and missalettes have been removed.

How to Prepare

Please take your temperature before arriving at the church.

You must bring your own mask and wear it at all times in the church.

Lower your mask only right before receiving Communion.

Wash your hands before coming to Mass. Hand sanitizer is available at the back of the church for use upon entering and exiting.

You are encouraged to bring your own hand sanitizer to use before Communion.

Practice social distancing at all times, including in the pews. Keep at least 6 feet of separation between families.

Follow the ushers' instructions when entering, leaving, and moving around the church to receive Communion.
