From Our Pastor:

¡BIENVENIDOS, PADRE JOSÉ!

The Archbishop assigned a new priest to help with Hispanic ministry on the Northshore, effective July 1 of this year. Fr José Leonel Cáceres Chávez was born in Concepción, Colombia to Serafin Cáceres and Marina Chávez. Being the eighth of twelve children, he grew up in humble beginnings in a faithful family. He earned a degree in Philosophy and Theology from the seminary in Bucaramanga before entering lay life as a teacher of Scripture at the lay institute for his diocese.

He wanted to further his studies and so earned a second degree in Philosophy and Religious Sciences from the University of St Thomas Aquinas in Bogotá. In addition, he also earned a specialist degree in Intellectual Development and Education from the University of Bucaramanga and the International Institute Alberto Merani in Bogotá. He finally earned a Master's in Pedagogy from the University of Santander, and is even a published author of the book *Path to Self-Reflection of Pedagogical Activity*.

He taught Philosophy and Religious Sciences in three private schools around Colombia before being elevated as a 16 year professor in the Department of Socio-Humanistic Studies at the University of Bucaramanga. It was there that the Lord called him from his country to New

Sus padres, Serafín Cáceres y Marina Chávez, con sacrificio y humildad formaron una gran familia con valores humanos y cristianos. Después de estudiar Filosofía y Teología en el Seminario Mayor de la Arquidiócesis de Bucaramanga, trabajó como profesor de Sagrada Escritura en la Escuela de Ministerios Laicos.

Realizó estudios avanzados en Filosofía y Ciencias Religiosas en la Universidad Santo Tomás de Aquino en Bogotá y obtuvo un título en Enseñanza de Educación Superior en la Universidad de Bucaramanga. Además, posee un título de Especialista en Desarrollo Intelectual y Educación de la Universidad de Bucaramanga y del Instituto Internacional Alberto Merani de Bogotá. Obtuvo su Maestría en Pedagogía de la Universidad Industrial de Santander, y es autor del libro *Camino a la Auto-Reflexión Sobre la Actividad Pedagógica*.

Trabajó como profesor de Filosofía y Ciencias Religiosas en tres escuelas privadas del país antes de pasar 16 años como profesor en el Departamento de Estudios Socio-Humanísti-


Orleans to study for the priesthood. Arriving in 2014, he was ordained a priest on June 3, 2017.

Are you a young adult, 18-35-ish? Theology On Tap is yours





You are a missionary


Because we live in mission territory, where we Catholics are a small minority, our RCIA ministry should be one of the most important and active in our parish. Yes, some of our neighbors think we secretly hide horns under our hair, and that our Church is from the devil. But there are others who are genuinely interested in our faith and need only the slightest of nudges to start on a path of conversion. Be on the lookout for these men and women who are asking questions about Catholicism, and invite them to at least start the RCIA process.

The process begins with the stage of inquiring. This is where questions are answered; where we talk about the story of Christ, the person of Christ, and a deeper relationship with Him through the action and life of the Church. It's a place not of judgment, nor even of the expectation of the curious to become Catholic, but first a place of learning and encounter. So we encourage you, *start those conversations* with those who have questions.
