An array of ways to stay connected with Holy Family

We try our best to make sure all our parishioners are informed of events and schedule changes. To do this, we employ a variety of means in addition to our weekly bulletin. Below is a list of points of contact that you may find helpful:

Holy Family's office: 985-839-4040. Someone is there to assist you Tues, Wed, and Thurs from 8 am-4 pm. Closed Mondays and Fridays.

Holy Family's website: Connects you to our bulletin, contact info, and more. We're set up to receive the Archdiocese of New Orleans' daily feed, covering news and events from across our region and the world-wide Church. Visit www.holyfamilyfranklinton.org.

Holy Family's MyParish app: In addition to sending out messages, the app is brimming with resources for living your Catholic life (daily Scripture readings, links to video and written meditations and reflections, kids' videos, guides to Confession, prayers, and more) as well as linking you to our own bulletin, calendar, schedule, and contact info. To download, text the word **app** to the number **88202** and follow the steps in the reply text you receive. If you don't text, go to your app store and search for **MyParish**.

Holy Family's Facebook page: Functions like a bulletin board. Parishioners and parish staff can post *important (please)* content. It's also where Fr Kyle is livestreaming his daily Mass. Use the Search window and type in **Holy Family Catholic Church**. Several search results will appear. Be sure you're selecting the one in Franklinton, LA (Franklinton, NC also has a Holy Family!). Once you land on our page, if you decide to become a member of the Facebook group, click on the **+Join Group** button. Then just answer a question or two; your request is typically approved within a day. Go to: <https://www.facebook.com/groups/holyfamilyfranklinton>.
