## FROM THE PASTORS DESK

### **Being a White Martyr**

Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Anthony's,

The other day we celebrated the feast of the Ugandan Martyrs, and today I would like to write a bit about the influence they have had on my life and priestly ministry.

It was June 3, 1886, exactly 100 years before I was ordained a priest, that these newly initiated Catholics were burned to death for their faith. Charles and his 22 companions, some of whom were of the Anglican faith, refused the request of King Mwanga to give into sexual perversion and commit acts of immorality with their bodies. Mwanga, was a violent ruler and pedophile who forced himself on young boys and men who served as court pages. Charles and his companions tried to bring faith to the evil king, but he would hear nothing of it. He condemned them to death by burning them alive.

Fast forward 100 years. I had just been ordained a priest in the Archdiocese of Washington on May 17th, 1986. As is the custom for all newly ordained priests, we were given a few weeks of vacation to go to other dioceses' to see our classmates ordained in their particular dioceses. I travelled out to Wichita, Kansas to see my roommate ordained and then came home by way of New Jersey to participate in some other ordination ceremonies. It was a time that I remember well, the springtime of the Church when new life is being brought forth.

I returned, finally, and reported to St. Ambrose Parish in Cheverly, MD. It would be my first assignment as a parish priest. I loved and still do love, this parish tucked away in the beautiful town of Cheverly. I arrived the night of June 2nd and unpacked my things. The pastor, Monsignor Kuehner, informed me that I had Mass the next morning. I was excited!! I looked over the readings for the Mass that night and discovered it was going to be the Mass of the Uganda Martyrs. I didn't know much about them, so I looked up in my book of the saints these holy souls and read about them in preparation for the next day.

These brothers became instant friends of mine from that time on. Little did I know how often I would turn to them for their help and support during my life in the priesthood. Only a few years later the Church, in the United States, would find itself in the midst of the first priest scandal. During the time of that scandal, as well as now, I look to the Ugandan Martyrs for help and support. They have never let me down.

The saints who have gone before us are not cut off and distant from the Church. They are very much alive and seeking to help us, who are still journeying through this world. All you need to do is to call them to assist you in your given need. The Church is in a massive clean-up operation which stretches from the ordinary person in the pew to the Pope himself. It's a purification that we all need. In this time, we need to pray for one another and purify our own hearts and minds. Let us as a parish pray for one another and support one another. May the letter of Peter remind us of this important truth. (1 Peter 5:7) "Stay sober and alert. Your opponent the Devil is prowling like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. Resist him, solid in your faith."
