Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
Weekend of June 16/17, 2018

In today's Gospel, Jesus compares the beginning of God's kingdom to a mustard seed. This tiny seed, which fits in the palm of a hand, can grow to fifteen feet with sprawling branches! Like the mustard seed, the Christian community had a tiny, seemingly insignificant beginning. The church, which began with about 120 followers, added three thousand people on Pentecost Day following the descent of the Holy Spirit. Since then, the number of Christ's disciples has grown incalculably and continues to grow throughout the world. Good stewards go about God's business of "planting seeds" among all those whom they encounter. What will we do this week to add to God's kingdom?

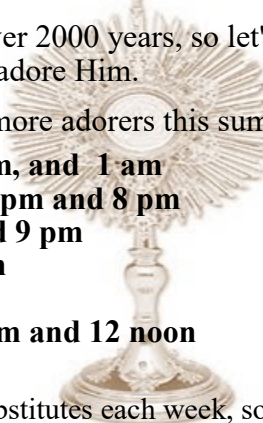

ONE BREAD, ONE BODY—Update—We have pledged \$54,656 towards our goal of \$90,421 for the annual archdiocesan appeal. We are over half way there. Given our ongoing financial needs for the parish as well as our efforts to pay down the debt on the church building I think we are doing very well. And while we have reached the goal for the One Bread, One Body campaign in the past, we need to make sure we continue to work towards doing so this year.

I firmly believe that if the amount of participation is increased we will easily make our goal. Last year 29% of the families contributed to reach our goal. We currently have 11.3 % of our families participating (Last year at this time we had 11.1%). Reaching a high participation goal is more important than the amount, although we are responsible for that also. But I am certain that if more families participate we will easily make our financial goal.
