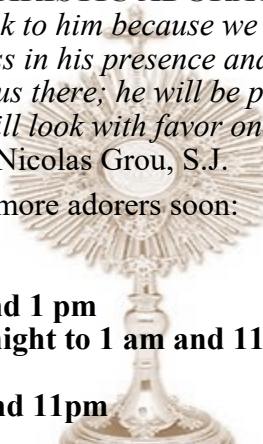

ONE BREAD, ONE BODY—UPDATE—We are three months into the annual archdiocesan stewardship campaign, One Bread, One Body. We started very strong but it appears that the initial surge has waned. We currently have received payments or pledges totaling \$61,979 of our \$90,421 goal (69%). This is about \$10,000 more than last year at this time. However, with our increased goal, from \$76,637 in 2017, we are roughly the same percent towards our goal.

We have been able to achieve this level with only \$13.5% of families participating (15.37% last year at this time). I am very confident that we could reach our financial goal immediately if we doubled the number of families participating. This campaign is important for the operations and programs of the Archdiocese. If you have not contributed to this fund, please prayerfully consider doing so.

Last year we achieved our goal during the last days of the campaign in March. It would be impressive to achieve our goal before the end of the year, something I do not recall us doing in the past.
