



## IMPORTANT PROTOCOLS July 20, 2020

- If you are exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19, have recently been around someone who tested positive for COVID-19 or have recently traveled on a commercial plane you should not enter.
- Only 4 people are permitted in the chapel at a time, unless ALL the people in the chapel are from the same household.
- Municipal ordinance requires wearing a mask mandatory.
- Sanitize your hands before entering and leaving the chapel.
- The scheduled adorer(s) are required to sanitize all the chairs and kneeler and use sanitizing clothes to wipe down any touchpoints after their scheduled time.
- Please bring a personal pen to record your participating in the log book.
- Do not use any of the books or touch anything in the chapel. If this is not possible (i.e., reposing the Blessed Sacrament) sanitize your hands before AND after touching anything.
- Enter the chapel is through the St. Joseph side (north) door and the exit is through the Blessed Mother or choir side (south) door.
- Keep chapel doors open all the time for ventilation and safety.
- If you use wipes to clean up, please TAKE YOUR TRASH WITH YOU.
- For the OPTIONAL transition prayers, pray something memorized such as Our Father, Hail Mary, etc.
- Bathrooms are open for use – please wash your hands there, too.
