Registration for 2021-2022 Begins February 3 – March 15, 2021

REGISTRATION FEES

**New 2021-22 – continuing your child’s education at St. Mary will be extremely easy. Your EFT account will reflect a \$100 draw on March 15, for each current student. This will reserve a spot for your child for the fall. If you are registering an additional child, please fill out the attached form, return it before March 15 and we will make the additional draw from your account. Those of you who decide not to return next year must notify the office in writing prior to March 15, in order to prevent the \$100 draw from your account. This non-refundable payment will be applied towards your tuition.

TUITION

Tuition can be paid in full by July 31st (or for new families registering after July 1st, paid 30 days after registering) for a 2% discount on tuition, or paid in 12 monthly EFT payments starting July 1st. The paid-in-full discount is available for Preschool through 8th grade.

**New 2021-22 - starting with the 2021-22 school year, there is no longer a fundraising fee! (This is the primary reason for the initial tuition increase.) Scrip rebates decrease tuition costs, with 60% of the rebate going to the family. Families can significantly decrease their tuition rates by buying Scrip.

**New 2021-22 – rebates earned from June 1st to December 31st can decrease current year tuition!

Families paying their tuition monthly will see their payment decrease starting in February with rebates earned between June and December. Rebates earned after December 31, will reduce next year’s tuition. If the tuition was paid in full up front, the rebates will decrease next year’s tuition.

Shown below are the tuition rates **per family**, based on the number of Preschool-8th grade students enrolled per family. Multiple student discounts are included in the rates shown below.

SCRIP REBATES

Families can decrease their tuition rates by participating in our Scrip program. By buying gift cards at face value from St. Mary and using them for gas, groceries, travel, and many other things, you share in the rebate the vendor gives to St. Mary. Spread the word to your family and friends – they can sign up to give their rebate to your family and help you decrease the cost of your tuition! Scrip rebates are shared 60% with the family and 40% to St. Mary. An example is shown below of how this can help your tuition rate.

Scrip rebates are only applied to tuition costs. Families paying their tuition by monthly EFT will see their current year’s payment decrease starting in February with rebates earned between June and December. If the tuition was paid in full up front, the rebates will decrease next year’s tuition. Rebates earned from January through May are applied to next year’s tuition. Rebates remaining in the family’s last year of school at St. Mary are donated back to the school or the tuition assistance fund.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS:

For example, a family buys a \$100 Woodman’s gift card from St. Mary for \$100. They use the gift card to pay for groceries instead of cash/debit. Woodman’s gives St. Mary a 5% rebate, or \$5 per \$100 card. St. Mary gives the family \$3 and keeps \$2 to help with operating costs. The more the family buys, the more rebates they accumulate, which are used for paying tuition. Vendors offer various levels of rebates, some over 10%.

HOW SCRIP REBATES HELP PAY TUITION

For example, a family bought gift cards that provided St. Mary \$800 in rebates. St. Mary shares 60% of this with the family, or \$480, which is applied to their tuition costs. If they had earned this between June and December, their monthly EFT payments from February to June will decrease by \$96/month.

OPPORTUNITIES OFFERED AT ST. MARY

AFTERCARE

Aftercare is offered daily from 3:00-6:00pm. The cost will be prepaid at the rate of \$10.00 per day. There is a \$25.00 registration fee, with a \$50.00 maximum per family. Separate registration materials will be provided to interested families.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

St. Mary is committed to providing a quality, Catholic education to all students regardless of their financial situation, but encourages you to apply for the Wisconsin Parental School Choice Program first. **Financial assistance is available for registered parish families of students in all grades.** Applications for tuition assistance are located on our web site. To apply, a family must complete the application and return it prior to March 15. Strict confidentiality is maintained with the family on any communications. Families need to reapply for tuition assistance annually.

WISCONSIN PARENTAL SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM

St. Mary Greenville participates in the Wisconsin Parental School Choice Program (WPCP). The WPCP allows students who reside in a Wisconsin school district to attend any participating private school if certain eligibility criteria are met and the students are selected in the random drawing conducted by the Department of Public Instruction (DPI). The private school, on behalf of the pupil's parent or guardian, receives payment from the state for each eligible student.

If your family's income places you at or below 220% of the federal poverty guideline, we encourage you to apply for the WPCP. The family income limits are shown below for reference:

This program is awarded to families on a lottery basis and covers the cost of the base tuition. If selected, this program would follow your child through 12th grade if you are able to prove residency. The open application period for the 2021-2022 school year is from February 1– April 15, 2021. RECRUITMENT INCENTIVE

We are looking to share the many blessings at St. Mary School with other families. As true disciples, we must go and spread the good news of our faith. What better way to “spread the word” than by inviting more families to join us! Any family that encourages a new family to enroll a student in St. Mary School will receive a \$100 credit on their family's tuition. You truly can be a supportive advocate of our school while sharing your faith. Catholic education continues to be an excellent value for your children. We appreciate the financial investment you are making in your child's education!

STATE TAX DEDUCTION

Remember to take advantage of the tax deduction for parents with children in private schools. Under this program, parents statewide will be able to deduct up to \$4,000 per student in grades K-8, and up to \$10,000 per high school student.

COMPANY MATCHING PROGRAMS

Please check if your employer participates in matching gift programs. Many companies will match gifts employees make to charitable organizations such as St. Mary School. These donations increase third source funding and support the operation of the school.

TUITION REFUNDS

If a student leaves St. Mary, tuition may be pro-rated based on the number of school days attended. For example, if a student withdraws in January and has attended for 90 days (50% of the total 180 days in a school year), the tuition would be pro-rated by 50%. All final decisions of whether refunds are given and the amounts are made by the administrator.

PAST DUE BALANCES

If circumstances occur affecting your ability to pay, please contact our office immediately so we can assist you in setting up a payment plan or applying for Tuition Assistance (see Tuition Assistance section). Otherwise, balances that are past-due may be subject to interest charges at a rate determined by the St. Mary Finance Council. We may use a collection agency for further action on past-due amounts.
