


The Diocese of Austin is a thriving and growing community of more than 500,000 brothers and sisters in Christ. Our faith-filled presence has had a profound influence on Central Texas, and we continue to welcome more and more faithful to our parishes and missions each year.

Our diocese has seen many changes over the last 70 years. In the last dozen years alone, the number of Catholics in our area has grown by more than 25 percent. To address the challenges and opportunities these changes have created, the diocese spent a year praying about, reflecting upon and discussing a vision for our future. This year of discernment resulted in *Encounter that Leads to Transformation*, our Pastoral Plan inviting all members of our diocese to a deeper encounter with Jesus Christ, leading to renewal and transformation of ourselves, our homes, our ministries and our community.



Strengthened by prayer, *Encountering Christ* allows us — in a spirit of stewardship and unity — to build a vibrant and secure future for the Diocese of Austin.

This campaign will raise a minimum of \$85 million to fulfill the vision of our Pastoral Plan and share in:

\$12 million to support our clergy

The men who dedicate their lives to serving us need our support at all stages of their journey. By supporting our clergy from seminary through retirement, we will encourage seminarians and priests to experience the fullness of their vocation, lifting them up as they help us consider and live out our own calling.



\$14 million to embrace discipleship

Fostering encounters with Jesus Christ leads to a deeper engagement that will transform our ministry, resulting in true missionary discipleship. Witnessing our faith is an essential part of Catholic-Christian discipleship.



\$20 million for emerging disciples

Our responsibility as Catholics is to ensure future generations of disciples are well-formed, prepared and excited to embrace and share their faith with our world. We continually seek to support the spiritual development of our children and young adults as well as engage them in educational and formational opportunities.

\$35.5 million to strengthen parishes



Our diocese benefits from the diversity of our 123 parishes and missions, which are urban and rural, small and large, multilingual, with schools and without. Given the critical role of parishes, ensuring their strength and sustainability is of the utmost importance.

Each parish in the diocese is rooted in the church but has its own identity and charism — and unique needs. *Encountering Christ* will have a significant impact on parishes, with \$22.5 million of the campaign's \$85 million goal remaining in parishes to address local needs. If we meet our campaign goal at Holy Family, we will receive \$24,000.

Our community was built by family, for family. We welcome all who walk through our doors as part of this family. Established in 1990, Holy Family has come a long way in a short period of time. We started as a mission with 20 families, and have

now grown to 70 families. In this short time span, we are blessed to have our new beautiful church, school building and parish activity center.

In 2011, we purchased the parish activity center building and later constructed an exterior commercial kitchen to support the needs of our growing community. This purchase required the assistance of the diocese, and we have been working to pay off the debt we incurred. Thanks to our generous community, we have made a great deal of progress on this loan. *Encountering Christ* will help us continue our efforts.



\$24,000 for debt repayment

Our parish activity center was a longtime dream that we are now able to enjoy. This space hosts all our parish ministries, such as youth programs, parish festivals and so many community events.



We are now focused on enjoying our parish activity center without the debt we incurred to purchase the building and remodel the space. Our combined debt, including our loan from the diocese, is around \$170,000, and we look forward to *Encountering Christ* providing another avenue to aid us. We will receive 30 percent of all gifts to the campaign until we reach our \$80,000 goal, and then will receive 70 percent of donations.

Let us reflect on the many blessings the Lord has given us. Recognizing that all of our material goods are gifts from the Lord, we are asked in the Gospel to give back a portion of these gifts in thanksgiving for God's generosity and goodness to us.
