Here is some helpful information:

**Chaperones:** Letters of invitation accompany this letter for all parents who have the appropriate security clearances. Please respond promptly.

**Cost of the Trip:** The cost of the trip, for students and chaperones, is **\$117.00** per person. *Please use the [PayNow](#) link to make payment by 5/10.*

**Itinerary:** We will follow the schedule above as closely as possible. A tour guide will be traveling with us. Chaperones will assist the students in boarding/disembarking the bus and will supervise small groups throughout the day. Please do not leave your group unattended at any time for any reason.

**Meals:** We will brown bag it for lunch. Please bring lunches in **disposable containers and bags**. The cost of dinner is included in the cost of the trip. We will be eating dinner at Bubba Gumps at the Baltimore Inner Harbor. The meal includes an appetizer, entree, dessert, and soft drink.

**Dress Code:** The students should wear their gym pants/shorts and their gym or Class of 2019 t-shirts. Comfortable sneakers are recommended for everyone! It is also recommended that students carry a small backpack or purse.
