COVID-19 Sick/Return to School Policy

Following the guidance of the Chester County Health Department, students presenting with current COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home from school and recommended for testing if they have:

A) **One** of the following: cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, or lack of smell or taste (without congestion).

OR

B) **Two** of the following: fever/elevated temperature, sore throat, chills, muscle pain, fatigue, headache, congestion/runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea.

In the event of a negative test and/or your child presents with only ONE symptom from group B, our standard illness policy requires a student to be symptom free and/or under treatment for 24 hours before returning to school.

Example: If a child is sent home on Monday, they may return to school on Wednesday ONLY if they have been asymptomatic all day on Tuesday.
