Welcome returning GOF, RE & new families!

We are very excited to get going again with in-person faith formation.

Registration in one of our programs for the 2021-2022 year will be ongoing from June through Catechetical Sunday (Sept. 19). However, please register as early as possible so that we can plan accordingly. You can find a **Parish Religious Education Registration Form** attached with this email, at the FDC welcome desk and on the parish website.

The registration fee is \$95 per child for the weekly classroom based Religious Education Program (RE) and \$160 per family for our family-centered Generations of Faith Program (GOF) that meets once a month. Please make checks out to "The Church of Saint Ann." You can also pay by credit card through Faith Direct found on the parish website. **Return of the registration form with payment will confirm registration of your children in one of our faith formation programs.** RE begins Sept. 26. Our first GOF session is on Sept. 18/19. We will email you confirmation of your registration with a link to your program schedule.

RE meets Sunday morning at 10:15 am to 11:30 am, and Monday evening at 6:00 pm to 7:15 pm (you need only choose one option). Sacramental prep grades 2, 7 & 8 will meet in the Faith Development Center (FDC). Grades 1, & 3-6 will meet in St. Ann School (SAS).

GOF (Generations of Faith Program), our family based program, is offered monthly Saturday morning at 9:30 a.m. to 11:15/11:30 a.m. and Sunday evening at 5:00 p.m. to 6:45/7:00 pm (you need only choose one option each month) September through April. Calling to mind the importance of family faith formation and life-long learning, I especially want to invite families currently in the RE program and those who are new, to consider our GOF program for your family/child. This faith formation program, which meets once per month or seven times for the year, is suited for today's families and provides an opportunity for parents to learn along with their children, develop their faith and take an active role in guiding the faith of their children.
