#### WELCOME TO GOF!

The Church of Saint Ann's faith formation program for families with children in grades 1-8.

- A STRUCTURED EXPERIENCE. Faith formation through seven sessions spread out between September and April. Each session lasts about an hour and forty-five minutes. Offered on Saturday mornings and Sunday evenings, you pick the one that best accommodates your schedule.\* Sunday Liturgy (Mass) is central and begins your week.
- A FAMILY EXPERIENCE. We accommodate the whole family with age appropriate faith formation, K-3, 4-6, 7-8, and adult. Families come together (at least one parent), share a meal, and are introduced to the monthly theme before breaking out into the activity sessions. The session closes with prayer.
- AN ONGOING EXPERIENCE. Empowering parents to faith and to share faith with their children, we provide, supporting resources for the home and activities to continue the conversation and enrich your journey.

## First Reconciliation & First Eucharist

#### **Sacrament Preparation**

The specific preparation for a child's celebration of Reconciliation and Eucharist will rest primarily with the family. The sacraments will be discussed in the children's session but because of the multiaged classrooms specific preparation cannot be done. The parish will provide support, encouragement and resources (Our Sunday Visitor/OSV, Encounter with Christ child book and parent guide). ## Confirmation 7th & 8th Grade Sacrament Preparation

The preparation for Confirmation is a two year period of preparation usually beginning in 7th grade. The program uses *Dynamic Catholic Design Point (required)* and Loyola Press—*Called to Be Catholic* (7th grade) and *Confirmed in the Spirit* (8th grade) along with parish/online resources that include all Decision Point videos.
