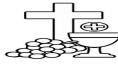

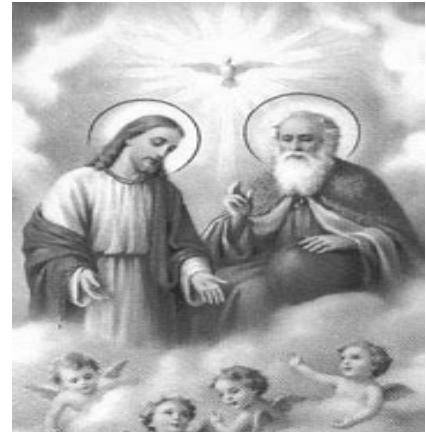

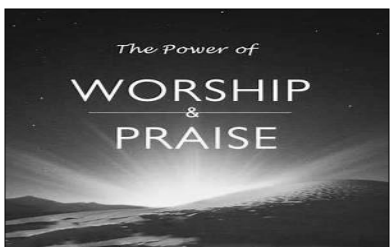

Dear Beloved Church Families,

Your pastor welcomes you back. I truly hope that you had a great week. Please know that you were in my prayers throughout the week. Today, we celebrate the Mystery of the Holy Trinity, and Fathers Day. The Mystery of the Holy Trinity consists of God our Father who reveals His love for us as one God in three persons. We celebrate God as the creator, the maker of mankind. Indeed, He is the Omnipotent God, the omniscient God and the Omnipresent God.

In Jesus the Son, He manifests His love for humanity by sending Him into the world to save His children. When He came, Jesus made it clear that He had come to fulfill the will of His Father. To do so, He reveals to us that God is loving, kind, merciful, and gracious. After His resurrection, He promised the disciples that He would come back where He will judge the living and the dead. Throughout His ministry, Jesus made it clear that His Father and He are one. Before being ascended to heaven, Jesus reminded the disciples of the importance of bearing witness to Him. Then, He promised the coming of the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete.

On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles. Indeed, His presence was felt by all the Apostles. Before leaving the disciples, Jesus outlined the role of the Holy Spirit. Moreover, Jesus told the disciples that His departure should be embraced with joy instead of sadness because He had to go to the Father in order to come back.

Church Family, today again, we are celebrating the Holy Trinity where God manifests His love for mankind as one God in three persons. I wish you a week filled with joy, happiness, good health, and many of God’s blessings. Again, may Jesus continue to order your steps in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
