COVID Testing Requirements:

- **What type of COVID test is required?**
- **Where is testing available?**
- **Do I need to submit test documentation?**

What Type of COVID Test is Required

If a student or staff member is experiencing symptoms and needs to be COVID tested, a diagnostic RT-PCR COVID test is required. Test results are typically back in 1-3 days, but can take up to a week. This is the test commonly used by community testing sites and doctor offices, but you should verify when scheduling.

A rapid antigen test is also available but will not be accepted, as there are inaccuracies in reporting negative results.

Where is Testing Available

Testing sites do change frequently. Here are some resources to utilize:

- Call your primary care doctor.
- The Wisconsin Department of Health has an update to date list of community testing sites on their website: <https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/covid-19/community-testing.htm>
- The Washington Ozaukee Public Health Department is providing testing to students and school staff. A referral is needed from the school. Once we are aware of a symptomatic situation, we will provide information regarding this testing.

Do I Need to Submit Test Documentation
