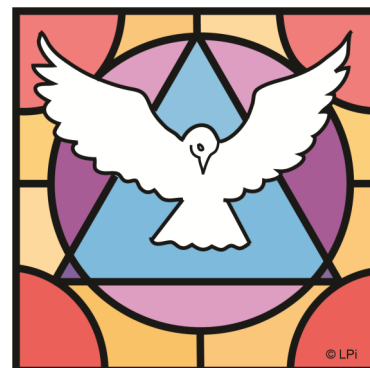

- Did you Know in the US.*
- New widows and widowers number 800,000 annually
 - Half of U.S. marriages end in divorce.
 - For every divorce, two adults grieve.
 - Over 1.1 million children are affected annually by divorce.
 - Divorce is the leading cause of childhood depression and suicide.
 - Rates of drug abuse and teen pregnancy are higher for children of the divorced.

It is amazing to consider how dramatically life changed for Jesus' disciples and other followers and for witnesses of his resurrection. Pentecost brought about huge transformations: fear into

courage, disbelief into belief, apathy into zeal, and maintenance into mission! Traveling outward into the world of the unfamiliar and sometimes hostile, the disciples set sail to proclaim the Good News to new people and new places. Their lives gave witness to many things, but one in particular became a huge game changer.

A true and real encounter with the Trinitarian God — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit — dramatically changed everything, including how they perceived God (in all His revealed fullness), one another, themselves, and creation.

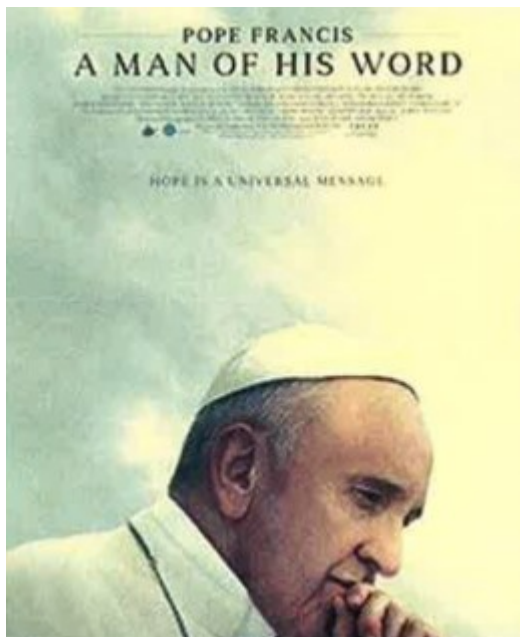
