**Roe and Doe legalized abortion through all nine months of pregnancy.**

Many people don't realize that *Roe v. Wade* legalized abortion through all nine months of pregnancy. *Roe* says abortions may not be restricted at all during the first three months and in the second three months may be regulated only for the mother's health.<sup>1</sup> After "viability"<sup>2</sup> *Roe* allows abortion to be prohibited but must make an exception for the woman's life or health.<sup>3</sup>

But in *Roe*'s companion case, *Doe v. Bolton*, the Court defined "health" to include "all factors—physical, emotional, psychological, familial, and the woman's age—relevant to the well-being" of the mother.<sup>4</sup> In most states, that is broad enough to permit virtually any abortion in the seventh, eighth, or ninth months of pregnancy<sup>5</sup> if any of these reasons is invoked.<sup>6</sup>

The central idea from the scriptures for this 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time is Self-Giving. All human beings by nature are social and interdependent. Therefore, we have an obligation to help each other out. But Christians are, in a sense, just one person, so that what any one of us has belongs to all of us. This also means that what God has belongs to us, too. In this life here on earth, our unity is safeguarded by charity, by the profession of the one faith received from the apostles, by the sacraments, above all the Holy Eucharist, and by apostolic succession (CCC 815). This unity is only threatened by sin and its harmful consequences (CCC 814) God's desire and our own deepest desire (if we are desiring aright) is communion. Communion literally means unity-with. Communion is the deepest friendship, resting on charity, which is willing the true good of the other. There is communion in faith, communion in the sacraments, communion of goods, communion in charity, communion among the three states within the church: of heaven, purgatory, and earth.
