## 31st Sunday of Ordinary Time

Deuteronomy 6:2-6; Psalms 18:2-3, 3-4, 47, 57; Hebrews 7:23-28; Mark 12:28-34  
Jesus Is Our "High Priest" and the Mass Is His "Once for All" Sacrifice

This upcoming week - Sunday, November 4 through Saturday November 10 - is National Vocation Awareness Week

For the last month a review has been undertaken of parish membership, both in number of families and individual people. There have been many instances of inconsistent or inaccurate information noted and I have found that after the "dead wood" has been removed from the parish rosters, we are getting a number that is more in line with the people who participate in their respective parish. Every year I have to report both to the Diocese as well as provide statistics to the Kenedy Directory that prepares the yearly report both to the Vatican as well as all the dioceses of the United States. By the use of the term dead wood, do not equate this in a derogatory mindset, but the identification of persons or families that have not been seen, heard from, or participated in the life of the parish.

There are couple of notations that I would like to share: (1) When a young adult finishes high school and does not continue their formal education, they are removed from their family listing because they have started to move out into the world and consequently should be registered under their own name. (2) When a person marries outside the faith, they are removed from the registry of the parish until such time that this marriage is brought into communion with the Catholic Church. That is to say that they have taken themselves out of communion through their own action and now do not have recourse to the sacraments (cannot receive the Holy Eucharist and to do so is a sacrilege). That is not to say they cannot attend Mass, but they have taken a step in their life that they can not fully participate in the life of the church. (3) The boundaries of the each parish are respected by the fact that if any inactive Catholic should died within those boundaries, the pastor of the Catholic church is responsible for that particular soul and will observe the corporal work of mercy by taking care of the dead. (4) When a child is conceived outside of the bonds of marriage, it is not the fault of the child, and should be baptized as soon as possible for their immoral soul.

These are just a couple items that have come up over the years. On the other side of the bulletin I have placed the information that has been forwarded to the Diocese and the Kenedy Directory.

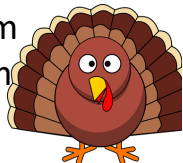

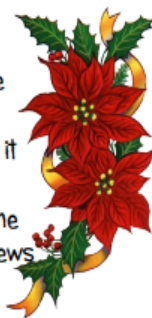

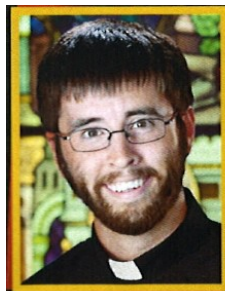
