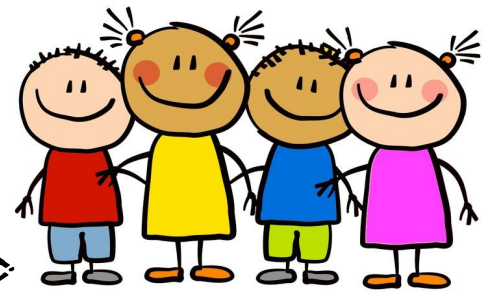

The Anointing of the Sick
 The main scriptural foundation for the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is in the Letter of James: “Is any among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord” (James 5:14).
 This sacrament is not just for the benefit of the afflicted person; the whole Church benefits when sufferings are offered up for her.
 The *Catechism* describes this as an “ecclesial grace”: “The sick who receive this sacrament, ‘by freely uniting themselves to the passion and death of Christ,’ ‘contribute to the good of the People of God.’ By celebrating this sacrament the Church, in the communion of saints, intercedes for the benefit of the sick person, and he, for his part, though the grace of this sacrament, contributes to the sanctification of the Church and to the good of all men for whom the Church suffers and offers herself through Christ to God the Father” (CCC 1522).
