Tuesday Adoration at OLPH

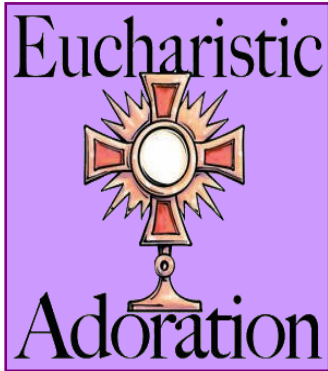
Is anyone interested in participating in a regularly scheduled Adoration time at OLPH? It would be held on

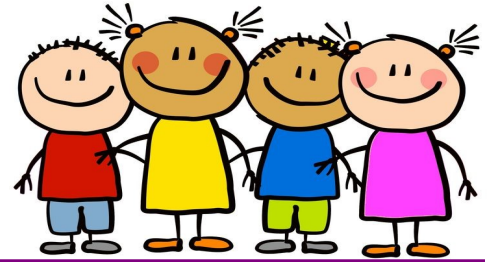

Religious Education

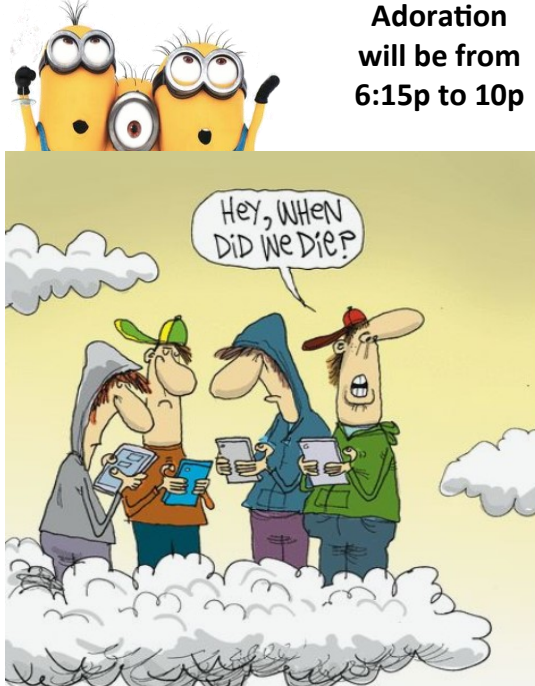
Registration forms are available on the parish website (olphsj.org) for both parishes. Please fill in and return as soon as possible. We have to plan for textbooks and support personnel.

Sometimes, God doesn't give us the answer to our prayers that we wanted. But that doesn't mean that he hasn't answered our prayer. St Padre Pio (of Petralcina) gave a beautiful analogy of this in one of his last sermons. He explained that we are like children sitting on the floor at our mother's knee. And God is like our loving mother, who is working on a piece of embroidery. Now the child can only see the underside of the embroidery hoop. From that perspective it looks like an absolute mess: the colors are all mixed up, there is no discernible pattern, nothing makes sense. But from the mother's perspective, the embroidery is slowly taking on its perfect, beautiful form. If the child were to complain that the mother is making a mess, the mother would smile and ask the child to be patient. And every once in a while, the mother might even give her child a little glimpse of the top of the hoop. Sometimes our prayers are like that. We think we know what's best, and we just don't understand why God doesn't grant our prayer. But actually we are only looking at the underside of God's Providence. We simply can't see the whole picture. His perspective, on the other hand, is complete. And so when he doesn't answer our prayers the way we would like him to, we can be sure that it's only because he has something better in mind.
