Bishop Folda emphasized yesterday at the Deans' meeting to remind priests that all scheduled penance services where entire parish is scheduled to attend at once are cancelled. Priests may hear confessions by appointment in more open spaces. I also am scheduling confession times 4:30-6:30 everyday in church where it is more open and controlling the under ten at a time rule. Confessions are not to be heard in the confessionals as the area is too closed in of a space.

## GUIDELINES FOR CELEBRATING HOLY WEEK DURING COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

**Palm Sunday:** Palms will be available at Noon on Palm Sunday. Hopefully the Blessing and Mass of Palm Sunday will be available for viewing on YouTube.

**Chrism Mass:** The Chrism Mass will be rescheduled for a later date.

**Holy Thursday:** Normally a priest is not permitted to celebrate a private Mass on Holy Thursday. Exceptional permission has been granted to all priests to celebrate Mass without the people on Holy Thursday this year. Please omit the washing of feet. The procession with the Blessed Sacrament at the end of Mass is also omitted. You may use one of two options to conclude the Mass 1) Immediately return the Blessed Sacrament to the tabernacle, and conclude Mass. 2) It may be less awkward if after the prayer after communion, you incense the Eucharist still in the ciborium on the altar, sing or recite the *pange lingua*, and then return the Eucharist to the tabernacle. In either case, the Eucharist should be removed from the tabernacle in the Church at some point after Mass and placed for safeguarding where you would normally put it at the conclusion of Holy Thursday adoration, allowing the church tabernacle to be empty through Good Friday up until the Easter Vigil.

**The Easter Vigil :** At the beginning of the vigil, the lucernarium (blessing of the fire) and procession with the paschal candle is omitted. Nevertheless, according to the Roman

Missal, Easter Vigil no. 13, when a fire is not lit, it may be adapted to the circumstances. In this case, it would be suitable to prepare the paschal candle, light it, and proclaim the *exultet*. During the baptismal liturgy, all that is strictly necessary is the renewal of baptismal promises. Nevertheless, if you desire to have Easter water available for the faithful, please follow Roman Missal, Easter Vigil no. 42: omit the litanies of the Saints, and proceed immediately to the blessing of water (no. 54).

**Live broadcasting:** The CDW directives indicated that live, (not recorded) broadcasting of the Triduum liturgies may be of benefit for the faithful. Bishop Folda would like to maintain this directive. Priests are free to live broadcast their private liturgies for the Triduum, and if they are not able, they may direct their parishioners to the Cathedral liturgies which will all be livestreamed.

## Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.
