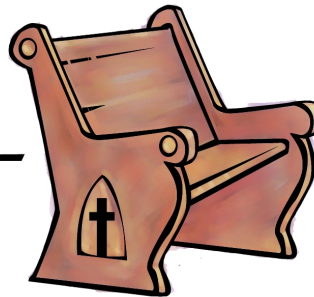

With today's gospel we enter the last week of Jesus' earthly life as he speaks with his disciples, preaches to the crowds, and spars with the chief priests and elders. These events take place in Jerusalem and the surrounding area just before and during the feast of Passover. Today Jesus confronts the chief priests and elders about their inability to change their position even after hearing the preaching of John the Baptist. By remaining entrenched in their own way of doing things, they are missing the work of God in their midst. It seems there is good news in today's parable as well, however: even if one originally refuses the request of God, there is still time to turn to him and do what is just.

Jesus said to them, "Amen, I say to you, tax collectors and prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God before you. When John came to you in the way of righteousness, you did not believe him; but tax collectors and prostitutes did. Yet even when you saw that, you did not later change your minds and believe him."

The teenage daughter said that she was staying out late and not to expect her home until midnight. Her parents told her to be home by ten, to which she replied, "Whatever." Later that night, around five minutes to ten, she came home. The parents were a bit puzzled and said, "Home already?" She replied, "Well, you said be home by ten." There is a difference between saying and doing, as reflected in today's gospel.

Two sons: Cain and Abel, Ishmael and Isaac, Esau and Jacob, the older brother and the Prodigal Son. Traditionally, the older son typically had the status, privilege, blessing, right of inheritance. However, the second sons Abel, Isaac, Jacob, and the Prodigal Son were, in fact, favored by God. Birth order does not assure God's blessings; rather, fidelity to "the way of righteousness" and doing God's will does.

CEMETERY RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The Cemetery Handbook can be found on our website Cemetery – Policies and Procedures.

Specifically, and in light of recent same-sex union burial questions, note in the handbook under Memorial Work, numbers 67-69 the requirement of written approval for all monuments, markers, etc., before they are allowed to be placed in a Catholic cemetery. While we cannot deny burial, we can ensure monuments adhere to Church teaching.

Have you ever met a flatterer, or people pleaser? Those who say what you want to hear but have no intention of following through? Or those who over-promise and under-deliver? It can be challenging to hear the words of Jesus in the parable today about such behaviors. Despite our best intentions, it is our actions that truly mean more than our words. Without actions, our words are a "clanging gong," to use a term from St. Paul. There are many reasons why we might over-promise, but we are reminded of another saying in the gospels: "Let your 'Yes' mean 'Yes' and your 'No' mean No" (Matt 5:37). At some level, this is simply good advice from Jesus the teacher.
