Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice” (Philippians 4:4). I am excited to greet you in this Easter season with joy in the victory of Jesus Christ over sin and death. In this time of pandemic and social unrest we are reminded all the more of our need to draw close to Christ who alone is our stability and hope.

As you may have heard, Bishop Folda has reinstated the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation, beginning on May 1. I, your pastor, especially look forward for us joining again as a whole body of our parish family after more than a year of separation. This occasion reminds me of the great gift that we have in the Mass.

For those of you who have not yet returned to Mass, I invite you to join us again the weekend of May 1-2. It will be a blessing to have you with us once again. In his official decree, Bishop Folda gave exemptions to the obligation. They are:

- Those who are ill;
- Those who have reason to believe they were recently exposed to Covid-19 or another serious or contagious illness;
- Those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or a nursing facility;
- Those who care for the sick, the infirm, and the homebound;
- Those who are unable to attend Mass through no fault of their own;
- Those with underlying health conditions or in a high-risk category;
- Those who have significant fear or anxiety of becoming ill by attending Mass.

If you are dispensed from attending Mass due to one of the exemptions, you can watch the livestream of the 10:00am Mass at the Cathedral of St. Mary in Fargo. You can access the link either by the diocesan website homepage at www.fargodiocese.org or by accessing the Diocese of Fargo YouTube page. If you wish, you may include the following: Mass is also broadcast every Sunday morning at 10:30 a.m. on WDAY / WDAZ television. If you have any questions about the obligation to attend Mass, please do not hesitate to contact me.

May the resurrected Christ fill you with His peace and joy during this Easter season.
