MOCAN Membership Drive Next Weekend

Do you want to be more involved in public policy, or to cast a more informed vote at the polls? Do you want your Catholic voice to be heard in the halls of the Capitol? You can make this happen by becoming a member of the Missouri Catholic Advocacy Network (MOCAN) of the Missouri Catholic Conference (MCC), the official public agency of the Catholic Church in Missouri. Next weekend, our parish will conduct a registration drive for MOCAN, during which you may register by text message or by filling out a MOCAN Enrollment Form. Through the involvement of Missouri Catholics, the MCC has won many legislative victories, including enacting a ban on partial birth abortions, expanding the A+ scholarship program to include private school students, and raising the age of juvenile jurisdiction for young offenders.
