Virtus Training Session

We will have a Virtus training session on Monday, September 30th, starting at 6PM. Virtus is an awareness session which better equips adults to protect children and vulnerable adults in the world around them. It is required for all parish volunteers who are in regular contact with children under the age of 18, but it is recommended for anyone who wants to help keep our children safe. To register for the class, use the "First Time Registrant" button on virtusonline.org, OR contact Fr. David for help registering.

Are you employed by a Catholic parish or school? Do you regularly volunteer with minors? If the answer is yes to either of these questions, you should be aware of the diocesan safe environment requirements. The primary obligations for any employee and for all volunteers who work with minors are:

1. Required to attend an adult safe environment training (VIRTUS),
2. Required to sign a Background Disclosure and Authorization form which will allow the diocese to conduct a criminal background screening on you.
3. Required to sign a diocesan Code of Conduct every year that you are employed or actively volunteering.

The Code of Conduct for 2019-2020 was released in July. If you fall into one of the above categories and have not signed the 2019-2020 Code of Conduct please contact your parish or school office.
