Hello my dear St. Eustachius parish friends!

Hello friends and family (shout out to my grandparents Francis and Sally Hulshof and Uncle Randy!). I wanted to thank you for your support through prayer and donations for my Apprenticeship in DC with the organization City Service Mission (CSM). I wanted to give you a small update and wish you a Merry Christmas! My Apprenticeship has taught me a lot of things about Christ, how to live in an urban setting, and how to serve long-term with the kids at the after school program in Maryland called City Gate Overland. I wouldn't be here without your prayers and financial support, so thank you! I love my new home parish St. Frances de Sales, which has a vibrant Latin mass community and Gospel choir-like community, too. I also love learning from the museums in DC, visiting Catholic University of America's adoration chapels, and working for this organization. City Service Mission (CSM) guides service groups that come in to serve Christ in Washington, DC. We help group members serve in a variety of settings, some examples being pregnancy resource centers, clothing stores, after-school programs and elderly day centers. CSM really encourages each person who serves on our trips to serve locally after they're done in DC. That's one of my favorite parts about CSM.

It's amazing how CSM loves their cities like Christ calls His followers to and encourage other people to do the same. I'll be in DC until August 2020, serving, researching, and learning. I can't believe I've already been here almost three months. The time is flying by, and it's sad and exciting all at once. Pray I relish every moment and praise God always!

I still need a little bit of help reaching my fundraising goal, so if you're interested in helping, please keep reading. My goal is to raise \$1,000/month, with \$200 of that money going to our DC community partners. (That is another cool part of serving with CSM - they continuously care for their partners throughout the year, not just during the busy summer season.) The rest of the money (\$800) goes towards my living expenses. Thanks to God and generous supporters, I'm at a pledged total of \$6,500 out of the total salary goal of \$11,000.
