All Saints Day & All Souls Day

The feast of All Saints' Day dates all the way back to the very first centuries of the Church. After the legalization of Christianity in 313, a common commemoration of the saints, especially the martyrs, appeared in various areas throughout the Church. In 609, the Emperor Phocas gave the Pantheon in Rome to Pope Boniface IV, who rededicated it on May 13 under the title St. Maria ad Martyres (or St. Mary and All Martyrs). The designation of November 1 as the Feast of All Saints occurred over time. Pope Gregory III (731-741) dedicated an oratory in the original St. Peter's Basilica in honor of all the saints on November 1 and this date then became the official date for the celebration of the Feast of All Saints in Rome. Along with the Feast of All Saints developed the Feast of All Souls. The Church has consistently encouraged the offering of prayers and Mass for the souls of the faithful departed in Purgatory. At the time of their death, these souls are not perfectly cleansed of venial sin or have not atoned for past transgressions, and thereby are deprived of the Beatific Vision. The faithful on earth can assist these souls in Purgatory in attaining the Beatific Vision through their prayers, good works, and the offering of Mass.

Indulgences for the Holy Souls

Indulgenced act: a special good work with special conditions of place and time.

Six General rules for obtaining a Plenary Indulgence: State of grace at least when performing the indulgenced act; Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; Confession (20 days before or after the indulgenced act); Communion (20 days before or after the indulgenced act); Prayers for the Supreme Pontiff (20 days before or after the indulgenced act)

Indulgenced acts to be performed for obtaining a Plenary Indulgence for the Poor Souls of Purgatory:

- From November 1 to 8: visit of a cemetery with mental prayer for the poor souls.
- On November 2: visit of a church or an oratory with one Our Father and one Creed being recited.

Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.

Young Single Adults Ministry

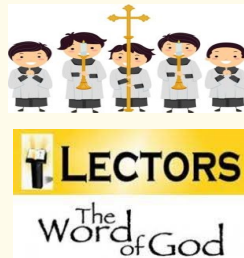

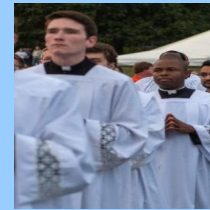
Next Second Collection
