This Week's Highlights

- 🔱 *One Church, Many Disciples* is reporting new gifts of approximately \$1 million.
- 🔱 Two weeks after the first of two launch meetings were held, Wave IV parishes have achieved 18% of the cumulative wave goal!
- 🔱 148 parish families have been visited resulting in 107 gifts, 37 pending decisions and only 4 declined.
- 🔱 The average gift thus far is \$16,200.
