This Week's Highlights

- ✚ *One Church, Many Disciples* is reporting new gifts of approximately \$1.3 million.
- ✚ Wave IV parishes have achieved 29% of the cumulative wave goal!
- ✚ 249 parish families have been visited thus far in the wave, resulting in 185 gifts, 57 pending decisions and only 7 declined—a 96% rate of giving.
- ✚ The average gift in this wave is currently \$14,300, the equivalent of a monthly pledge of nearly \$240 for 60 months.
