Campaign Progress

- Parishes in Wave IV have raised more than \$4.8 million to date; 48% of the wave goal.
- Congratulations to Sacred Heart, Hinton; Holy Trinity, Okarche; St. Eugene, Weatherford; Immaculate Heart of Mary, Calumet; and Our Lady of Guadalupe, Hollis, for reporting increases in gifts received since last Wednesday of 20% or more of their individual parish goals!
- Congratulations to St. Francis of Assisi, OKC for surpassing \$1 million!
- The overall campaign has raised \$81.6 million to date. Every dollar raised over the challenge goal of \$80 million helps strengthen local parish and shared ministries!

Visits = Gifts

It sounds so simple. Guess what? It is! Time after time, in previous waves and now in Wave IV, pastors and volunteers have experienced generous responses to their requests for gifts to *One Church, Many Disciples*. By now, most families in Wave IV parishes and throughout the archdiocese have learned of the exciting and worthy projects being funded through this first-ever, archdiocesan-wide campaign.

In the advance gifts phase currently underway in Wave IV, we are visiting with families who are among the most dedicated and generous in the parishes. They are highly likely to make their gifts when you meet with them. So simply set a date, share your passion, tell the story and give them the materials with Father's request letter. Then assist them with the completion of their pledge cards.

The advance phase is scheduled to end in a few weeks in Wave IV parishes. Please schedule and complete visits with your assigned families as soon as you are able. Receiving their gifts now will add to the momentum of the campaign in your parish. Please keep in mind that during the campaign all families in the 107 parishes in central and western Oklahoma will be asked for their gifts.

Here are helpful hints for scheduling visits:

- Set time aside—The easiest way to get started is to set aside 45 minutes to an hour and make all your scheduling calls at once.
- Know your schedule—If you have your schedule handy, you will be able to suggest specific times to meet with families. Offer two dates and times when scheduling to make it easier to find an agreeable time to meet.

- Your primary goal is scheduling the visit—remember you don’t need to explain the campaign over the phone, just to set a time to meet.
- Smile—even over the phone, smiling is proven to convey your natural enthusiasm and will set a positive tone for your conversation.

Weekly Report Meeting Tip: Celebrate small victories. This can include achieving parish benchmarks, e.g. 50% of your parish goal; a volunteer couple closing their first gift, etc.
