This Week's Highlights

- One Church, Many Disciples is reporting new gifts of approximately \$1.2 million.
- Wave IV parishes have raised nearly \$6 million; 60% of the cumulative wave goal!
- 710 parish families have been visited thus far in the wave, resulting in 495 gifts, 189 pending decisions and only 26 declined. The pace of activity remains high as we work to reach all families.
- The first 5 parishes in Wave IV went over goal this week! Overall, 64 parishes have achieved their goals throughout the archdiocese.
- Congratulations to Queen of All Saints, Sayre; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Hollis; St. Catherine of Siena, Pauls Valley; Holy Trinity, Okarche; and Ss. Peter and Paul, Hobart for surpassing their campaign goals!
