### This Week's Highlights

- 🔔 *One Church, Many Disciples* is reporting new gifts of approximately \$800,000.
- 🔔 Wave IV parishes have raised nearly \$6.7 million; 68% of the cumulative wave goal!
- 🔔 901 parish families have been visited thus far in the wave, resulting in 632 gifts, 230 pending decisions and only 39 declined. More than 9 of 10 decisions are resulting in gifts.
- 🔔 Congratulations to Sacred Heart, Mangum and Immaculate Heart of Mary, Calumet in Wave IV and to St. Joseph, Hennessey from Wave III for surpassing their campaign goals!
- 🔔 Overall, 68 parishes have met or surpassed their goals.
