### This Week's Highlights

- ✚ *One Church, Many Disciples* is reporting new gifts of more than \$800,000.
- ✚ Wave IV parishes have raised more than \$8 million; 81% of the cumulative wave goal!
- ✚ 1,184 parish families have been visited thus far in the wave, resulting in 867 gifts, 247 pending decisions and only 70 declined. So far, 92% of all decisions in Wave 4 have resulted in gifts.
- ✚ Congratulations to Rev. Christopher Tran and the volunteers at Sacred Heart, Hinton for surpassing their campaign goal this week!
- ✚ Archdiocesan-wide, 72 parishes have met or surpassed their goals.
