Campaign Progress

- Parishes in Wave IV have raised more than \$5.4 million to date; 55% of the wave goal.
- Congratulations to Our Lady of Guadalupe, Hollis; Ss. Peter and Paul, Hobart; St. Cornelius, Cherokee; St. Catherine of Siena, Pauls Valley; and Sacred Heart, Mangum, for reporting increases in gifts received since last Wednesday of 20% or more of their individual parish goals!
- Congratulations to Queen of All Saints, Sayre; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Hollis; and St. Catherine of Siena, Pauls Valley for exceeding their goals!
- So far, 62 churches have exceeded their goals throughout the archdiocese.
- The overall campaign has raised \$82.5 million to date. Every dollar raised over the challenge goal of \$80 million helps strengthen local parish and shared ministries!

Follow-up Tips

Often, families will ask for time to pray about their requested pledge for *One Church, Many Disciples*. This is a good sign that shows the visit went well and they are taking the request seriously! Like so many things in life, timing of the follow-up is everything. It is recommended that follow-up contacts take place 5-7 days after the initial gift request visit. Below are suggestions for ways to follow-up visits.

- When we met last, you requested time to pray about Father's request for a pledge to *One Church, Many Disciples*.
- Would you be available to meet with me for just a few minutes at your home, the church or the parish office to discuss your decision?
- We are concluding this phase of the parish campaign very soon, and we want to include your pledge with those of the many other generous parish families.
- Your gift will help build momentum, which is key to our ultimate success.
- The parish will be going public with the campaign in a matter of weeks and want to make sure we show solid support up front. We would be grateful to be able to include your gift in our total raised to date.

- Your pledge will influence and inspire other parish families to give – and we have many families yet to inspire!
- Can I answer any questions to help you come to a decision about your pledge?

Weekly Report Meeting Tip:

It is helpful to look at the parish campaign statistics together to make visible the path to achieving the parish goal. Here is an example:

- ❑ After completing 25 visits, a parish has raised \$200,000 which is 50% of its \$400,000 goal from 20 pledges averaging \$10,000. 20/25 provides a rate of acceptance of 80%.
- ❑ There are 15 more packets assigned to volunteers in the Advance Phase. When those visits have been completed, assuming an 80% acceptance and a \$10,000 average gift, there is potential for 12 more advance gifts totaling \$120,000.
- ❑ This leaves \$80,000 to raise from the remaining families in the parish which should be very manageable.
