Campaign Progress

- Parishes in Wave IV have raised nearly \$7.1 million to date; 72% of the wave goal.
- Congratulations to Sacred Heart, Mangum; Ss. Peter and Paul, Hobart; Immaculate Heart of Mary, Calumet; St. Mary, Ardmore; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Hollis, for reporting increases in gifts received since last Wednesday of 20% or more of their individual parish goals.
- Congratulations to Immaculate Heart of Mary, Calumet; Sacred Heart, Mangum; St. Andrew, Moore; and St. Mary, Ardmore for surpassing their goals!
- So far, 70 churches have exceeded their goals throughout the archdiocese.
- The overall campaign has raised \$84.3 million to date. Every dollar raised over the challenge goal of \$80 million helps strengthen local parish and shared ministries!

Pledges—a Natural Part of a Campaign's Success:

- ✦ Families usually can give more over time than all at once.
- ✦ Regular monthly or annual payments allow families to budget their giving.
- ✦ A pledge is a leap of faith – it represents a long-term commitment to the Church.
- ✦ A pledge is not legally binding. Situations and circumstances for families may change over time. A family may adjust a pledge at any point throughout the campaign period to account for unforeseen circumstances.
- ✦ Visits are the best way to share the campaign story with fellow parishioners and encourage their prayerful consideration of pledges over five years.
