### **Campaign Progress**

- Parishes in Wave IV have raised \$7.7 million to date; 78% of the wave goal.
- Congratulations to Blessed Sacrament, Thomas; St. Catherine of Siena, Pauls Valley; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Hollis; Immaculate Heart of Mary, Calumet; St. Francis Xavier, Sulphur, for reporting increases in gifts received since last Wednesday of 20% or more of their individual parish goals.
- Congratulations to Blessed Sacrament, Thomas for surpassing its goal!
- So far, 71 churches have exceeded their goals throughout the archdiocese.
- The overall campaign has raised \$85.2 million to date\*.

*\*Every dollar raised over the challenge goal of \$80 million helps strengthen local parish and shared ministries!*

### **Activity is the Key to Success**

- There are 1,921 families in the Cornerstone, Leadership, Major and Advance phases of which 1,562 have been assigned to be visited.
- 93% of Wave IV families contacted have made pledges averaging \$9,300.
- When evaluating your campaigns, ask yourselves and your director these questions:
  - How many families in these phases have we visited personally?
  - From how many families in these phases have we received a decision?
  - How can we invite these families to finalize their gifts in the next few weeks?
- Speak with your parish campaign director about strategies to personally invite every family in these phases to consider supporting *One Church, Many Disciples*.
