This Week's Highlights

Please note: This week's report is on a Thursday because of a Friday all-staff retreat for the Catholic Pastoral Center. Increases from parishes meeting tonight will be reflected in the next report after Easter.

- ✚ *One Church, Many Disciples* is reporting new gifts of \$600,000.
- ✚ Wave IV parishes have raised \$9 million; 91% of the cumulative wave goal!
- ✚ 1,381 parish families have been visited thus far in the wave, resulting in 1,063 gifts and 220 pending decisions.
- ✚ Congratulations to Father James Goins and the volunteers at St. Thomas More, Norman and Father Christopher Tran and the volunteers at St. Eugene, Weatherford for surpassing their campaign goals!
- ✚ Archdiocesan-wide, 75 parishes have met or surpassed their goals.
