Campaign Progress

- Parishes in Wave IV have raised \$8.5 million to date; 86% of the wave goal.
- Congratulations to St. Joseph, Pond Creek; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Hollis; Sacred Heart, Hinton; Ss. Peter and Paul, Hobart; St. Catherine of Siena, Pauls Valley and St. Wenceslaus, Prague for reporting increases in gifts received since last Wednesday of 20% or more of their individual parish goals.
- Congratulations to St. Joseph, Pond Creek and Sacred Heart, Hinton for surpassing their goals!
- So far, 73 churches have exceeded their goals throughout the archdiocese.
- The overall campaign has raised \$86.2 million to date.

Special and General Phase Pulpit Announcement for April 6-7

Pastors are asked to please make this announcement from the pulpit at Masses this coming weekend:

- Our parish is participating in the fourth and final Wave of the One Church Many Disciples campaign.
- When this wave is complete, all 107 parishes in the archdiocese will have participated in this historic effort to build the Shrine for Blessed Stanley Rother, strengthen parishes and provide long term funding for faith formation programs and ministries.
