Please note, some parishes may be on a slightly different timeline. Parish campaign directors will work with pastors and volunteers to implement each step and activity.

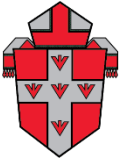

*Please note: the 10% credit parishes receive from gifts obtained by Archbishop Coakley are counted toward the individual parish goals but excluded from the total raised in the wave. This avoids double counting of gifts.
