- Parishes in Wave IV have raised \$9.9 million to date; 100% of the wave goal.

- Now, 16 of the 31 parishes in Wave IV parishes have surpassed their goals.
- So far, 76 churches have exceeded their goals throughout the archdiocese.
- The overall campaign has raised \$87.9 million to date.
