Entrance: Be Thou My Vision

1. Be thou my vision, O Lord of my heart
Naught be all else to me, save that thou art
Thou my best thought, by day or by night
Waking or sleeping, thy presence my light

2. Be thou my wisdom, and thou my true word
I ever with thee and thou with me, Lord
Thou my great Father, and I thy true son
Thou in me dwelling and I with thee one

3. Riches I heed not, nor vain, empty praise
Thou mine inheritance, now and always
Thou and thou only first in my heart
High King of heaven, my treasure thou art

Responsorial Psalm: *Fill us with your love O Lord, and we will sing for joy!*

Presentation of Gifts: You Alone

Refrain: You alone are holy, you alone are Lord. You alone are worthy to be honored and adored. Mercy you have given, kindness you have shown. Love is you alone.

Verse 1: Who of us is sinless in this place? Who of us deserves your saving grace?

Who of us is good at all without your blessed love that falls upon our hearts to heal our brokenness?
(*refrain*)

Verse 2: What is there to do but thank you, then, for the gift that we might call you friend? Greater love has not been known than that for which you gave your only son, that you might see us pure and blessed. (*refrain*)

Communion: Ubi Caritas

Refrain: Ubi caritas est vera, est vera. Deus ibi est, Deus ibi est.

Verse 1: The love of Christ joins us
together Let us rejoice in him
And in our love and care for all
now love God in return. (*refrain*)

Verse 2: In true communion let us

gather May all division cease
and in their place be Christ the Lord
Our risen Prince of Peace. *(refrain)*

Verse 3: May we who gather at this
table To share the bread of life
become a sacrament of love
Your healing touch, O' Christ. *(refrain)*

Verse 4: For those in need make us your
mercy for those oppressed, your might Make
us your Church a holy sign of justice and
new life. *(refrain)*

Verse 5: May we one day behold your
glory and see you face to face
rejoicing with the saints of God
to sing eternal praise. *(refrain)*

Sending Forth: Lead Me, Lord

Verse 1: Blessed are the poor in spirit
Longing for their Lord
For God's coming kingdom shall be theirs
Blessed are the sorrowing
For they shall be consoled
And the meek shall come to rule the world

Refrain:

Lead me, Lord, lead me, Lord
By the light of truth
To seek and to find the narrow way
Be my way, be my truth
Be my life, my Lord
And lead me, Lord, today.

Verse 2: Blessed are the merciful, for mercy shall be
theirs And the pure in heart shall see their God Blest are
they whose hunger only holiness can fill, For I say they
shall be satisfied. *(refrain)*
