Marriage

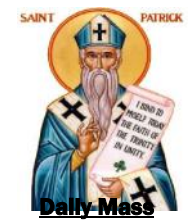
 The **Sanctuary Light** will burn this week in loving memory of **Mitchell Jurusich**.
